As you know, I begin my column each week with this salutation: "My Brothers and Sisters in the Risen

Lord" to commemorate the most important day of the Church's calendar year: the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Like many others, I carry this day in my heart, as it is the culmination of all I believe in and treasure.
