HEALTHY THOUGHTS: HOW TO IMPROVE YOUR DAY IN FIVE MINUTES: *(Here are some suggestions from the Health and Wellness Committee at St. Boniface provided by the ERS Parish Health Ministry.)* Five minutes...it's only a little bit of time. But it's long enough for you to do at least one. So take five minutes and try one of these simple ways to lower stress, boost your mood, and get more energy. It might give you that extra spark you need to meet the challenges of the day.

- **Pray/meditate.** Find a comfortable place in your home. At times, distracting thoughts pop up in your mind, but just let them float by and turn your attention back to your breath or prayer. Praying/meditating daily, even just for a few minutes, will strengthen your spirit.
- **Turn on the tunes.** Several studies have found that listening to music can help lower blood pressure, reduce stress, and boost mood. Put on a record or CD that will make you smile whether you're relaxing or working on a task.
