JUST TO LET YOU KNOW

THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD: The Transfiguration of Christ is the culminating point of His public life, as His Baptism is its starting point, and His Ascension its end. Moreover, this glorious event has been related in detail by St. Matthew (17:1-6), St. Mark (9:1-8), and St. Luke (9:28-36), while St. Peter (2 Peter 1:16-18) and St. John (1:14), two of the privileged witnesses, make allusion to it. Jesus took with him Peter and James and John and led them to a high mountain apart, where He was transfigured before their ravished eyes. "His face did shine as the sun: and his garments became white as snow." This dazzling brightness which emanated from His whole Body was produced by an interior shining of His Divinity. The Transfiguration of the Lord is celebrated on Thursday, August 6.

OF MASKS: Governor DeWine issued an order effective Thursday, July 23 at 6:00 P.M. mandating face coverings while in public in all counties in Ohio. People in these counties are required to wear a face covering:

- In any indoor location that is not a residence;
- When outdoors and unable to consistently maintain a distance of six feet or more from individuals who are not members of their household; or
- While waiting for, riding, driving, or operating public transportation, a taxi, a private car service, or a ride-sharing vehicle.

The order does not apply to children under the age of 10 or any other minor who cannot safely wear a face covering.

Strongly encouraging Mass attendees to wear a mask is consistent with the Archdiocese's emphasis on public safety and the common good. Thank you.
