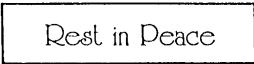

ST. PETER IN CHAINS CATHEDRAL: Pope Francis renamed our Cathedral a “minor basilica” on Saturday, August 16. This strengthens the historic landmark’s ties to Rome and recognizes its “artistic beauty.” The honor comes just a few months before the 175th anniversary of the cathedral’s dedication and makes it one of just 89 basilicas in the United States. It’s the sixth basilica in Ohio and the first in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. “This is a great blessing and honor that has been bestowed on our cathedral church,” said Archbishop Dennis Schnurr, who announced the Pope’s decision during the Mass on August 15 at the cathedral.
