LORD OF THE MIRACLES (EL SEÑOR DE LOS MILAGROS): Today at 2PM we will be celebrating the Lord of the Miracles with our Hispanic community on the lawn outside of church. You may have seen the shrine in the back of Church. This is a small replica of El Señor de los Milagros. The story tells that the image of the Cristo Moreno (Brown Christ) was painted by a slave of Angolese provenance on a small adobe wall in the Barrio of Pachacamilla in the center of Lima. The devotees, mostly slaves, started to congregate around the image and began to worship it, building a small temple around it. During the earthquake of 1655 all of the structure collapsed, except for the small wall where the image was painted. As Lima is a city prone to experiencing earthquakes, this occurrence repeated itself several times throughout the years. After each earthquake the image of El Señor de los Milagros remained undamaged. This resulted the existing adoration to continue to grow. El Señor de los Milagros is one of the most popular religious celebrations in Latin America. Please join us!
