**CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT:** Today is the annual collection for CCHD. Now, more than ever, people throughout our Archdiocese, our Country, and our world are finding themselves struggling just to survive. Through this campaign, the poorest of the poor are given opportunities to learn job skills, for youth to develop leadership skills, and for local leaders to secure decent housing and public services for our people. Two-thirds of the collection is sent to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and one-third is kept right here in our Archdiocese.
