WEARING OF MASKS: Governor DeWine issued an order effective July 8 at 6:00 p.m. mandating face coverings while in public in high risk, “Red alert Level 3” counties. In our archdiocese, these include Butler, Hamilton and Montgomery counties. People in these counties are required to wear a face covering:

- In any outdoor location that is not a residence;
- When outdoors and unable to consistently maintain a distance of six feet or more from individuals who are not members of their household; or
- While waiting for, riding, driving, or operating public transportation, a taxi, a private car service, or a ride-sharing vehicle.

The order does not apply to children under the age of 10 or any other minor who cannot safely wear a face covering.

Strongly encouraging Mass attendees to wear a mask is consistent with the Archdiocese’s emphasis on public safety and the common good. Thank you.
