THE HEALTH AND WELLNESS MINISTRY will do Blood Pressure Screenings after every Mass this Sunday. The *Go Red Women* movement works to make sure women know they are at risk so they can take action to protect their health. The American Heart Association has a few basic tips for women about what it means to *Go Red*:

- **G:** Get your Numbers- Ask your doctor about your blood pressure and cholesterol.
- **O:** Own Your Lifestyle- Stop smoking, lose weight, exercise and eat healthy.
- **R:** Realize Your Risk- Learn more about risk factors for heart disease.
- **E:** Educate Your Family- Make healthy food choices for you and your family.
- **D:** Don't Be Silent- Tell all the women you know that heart disease is the No. 1 killer of women. The good news is that nearly 80% of cardiac events can be prevented with lifestyle changes and education. While there are some risk factors you can't control, there are many that you do have control over. Heart disease is no longer a "man's disease," as the myth goes.
