



MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY: Martin Luther



King Jr. Day is a federal holiday falling on the third Monday of every January. This year it is on <u>Monday, January 20</u>. The day, also celebrating King's birthday, honors his legacy and shines a light on

civil rights. The holiday was approved as a federal holiday in 1983, becoming the first federal holiday honoring an African American. Martin Luther King, Jr., original name Michael King, Jr., (born January 15, 1929), in Atlanta, Georgia. He died April 4, 1968 in Memphis, Tennessee. He was a Baptist minister and social activist who led the civil rights movement in the United States from the mid-1950s until his death by assassination in 1968.
