Thursday, the fortieth day of Easter. The **Ascension of the Lord** will be celebrated on the Seventh Sunday of Easter in Ohio dioceses. With permission from Rome, the Catholic bishops of Ohio decided to move the yearly celebration of the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord from Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the Seventh Sunday of Easter. This change has been in effect since the first celebration on June 4, 2000.

**FEAST OF ST. BONIFACE:** St. Boniface, known as the apostle of the Germans, was an English Benedictine monk who devoted his life to the conversion of the Germanic tribes. He is the patron Saint of Germany, the first Archbishop of Mainz and the "Apostle of the Germans." The Holy Father instructed him to reform the German Church. He met with great problems because of lay interference in bishops' elections, the worldliness of the clergy and lack of papal control. During a final mission in 754, he and about 50 companions were massacred while they were preparing converts for Confirmation.

In St. Boniface Church the first window in the left wing is of St. Boniface. In this picture he is cutting down the large oak the pagan barbarians worshipped. His feast day is Wednesday, June 5.
