Stewardship Report to the Parish

October through December the food pantry served 944 persons (125 Seniors, 399 Adults and 420 Children) from 306 households. We were able to help those in need thanks to the generous financial and in-kind support of St. Boniface Parishioners, St. Ann and Bank Street SVdPs, Kroger, our St. Boniface Vincentians, LaSalle and St. Xavier HS Food Drives, The Miami Valley Lady Golfers and our families and friends. The estimated value of the donated items exceeds \$7,000.

Our Active and Associate Vincentians gave over 400 hours of service to our neighbors in need, including:

- 8 Home visits were made directly impacting the lives of 20 people and 21 other in person visits assisting 65 persons
- 26 Clothing/housewares vouchers were issued
- 7 Furniture vouchers were issued
- 7 Families received bed vouchers
- 2 Families received rent assistance
- 4 Families received utility assistance
- 1 Family received furnishings from New Life Furniture
- Phone calls were made to plan visits, arrange for vouchers or refer needs to other appropriate service agencies
- Conference meetings and Council meetings including First Friday Formations, Christmas Event; delivery, sorting, setting up and working at the Food Pantry; assisting families with Christmas presents for children

2019 marked 150 years of the SVdP Society in Cincinnati neighbors helping neighbors in need, growing in holiness, and sharing fellowship.
