

St. Boniface St. Vincent DePaul Conference 2019 First Quarter Stewardship Report to the Parish

January through March the food pantry served 789 persons (126 Seniors, 340 Adults and 323 Children) from 272 households. We were able to feed the hungry thanks to the generous financial and in-kind support of St. Boniface Parishioners and School, CAIN, Kroger and St. Boniface Vincentians. The estimated value of the donated food, personal care contributions, cleaning supplies and other donated items exceeds \$4,300.

Our Active and Associate Vincentians gave over 350 hours of service to our neighbors in need, including:

- 15 Home visits were made directly impacting the lives of 58 people and 16 other in person visits assisting 50 persons
- 22 Clothing/housewares vouchers were issued
- 11 Furniture vouchers were issued
- 9 Families received bed vouchers
- 2 Families received rent assistance
- 1 Family received utility assistance
- Phone calls were made to plan visits, arrange for vouchers or refer needs to other appropriate service agencies
- Conference and Council meetings; SVDP Retreat; preparing and working at the Food Pantry; making deliveries

2019 marks 150 years of the SVdP Society in Cincinnati neighbors helping neighbors in need, growing in holiness, and sharing fellowship.
