## **Stewardship Report to the Parish**

July through September the food pantry served 987 persons (128 Seniors, 460 Adults and 399 Children) from 318 households. We were able to help those in need thanks to the generous financial and in-kind support of St. Boniface Parishioners, Kroger, our St. Boniface Vincentians and families/friends. The estimated value of the donated items exceeds \$3,500.

Our Active and Associate Vincentians gave over 300 hours of service to our neighbors, including:

- 15 Home visits were made directly impacting the lives of 33 people and 18 other in person visits assisting 65 people
- 22 Clothing/housewares vouchers were issued
- 8 Furniture vouchers were issued, plus 1 delivery voucher
- 6 Families received bed vouchers
- 3 Families received rent assistance
- 5 Families received utility assistance
- 1 Family received assistance with background check for employment
- 2 Families received furnishings from New Life Furniture
- 1 Family participated in "Day to Dream" for kids' beds from Morris Home Furnishing
- Kids received backpacks and school supplies in August
- 1 "twinning" with nearby conference to assist a neighbor
- Phone calls were made to plan visits, arrange for vouchers or refer needs to other appropriate service agencies
- Conference meetings and Council meetings including, Annual Officers' Meeting, First Friday Formations; preparing and working at the Food Pantry; Freestore Foodbank and SVdP Pantry Meetings

2019 marks 150 years of the SVdP Society in Cincinnati neighbors helping neighbors in need, growing in holiness, and sharing fellowship.
