### SECRETARY REPORT - Casey Scullin

- Will often inform people who are "outliers" that location of other resources

## **OLD BUSINESS**

- District Council Presidential Election Barb
  - Our election results: 6 votes for the gentleman and 5 for the lady
  - To date, only 25% of the conferences have submitted their votes to Bank Street so election is not yet over
- St. Ursula Meeting(Sept 15) Barb
  - o Girls will work 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month, but....
  - o Girls have other commitments so sometimes are little late or absent
  - o Next Weidner child (Abbie) is the head of the St Ursula group
  - Checking to see if the girls can cover the 11/11 pantry as there is also Ozanam meeting
- FreeStore Food Bank Appreciation Meeting (Aug 31) Sue/Dave/Barb
  - No longer need to take civil rights training on line since Barb, Sue and Dave went to the Free Store training
  - Sue shared "aha" moments
    - Branding develop materials the contain a story and an associated picture to help with fund raising
    - Computer tracking program supports requests for grant money; good for capturing client data; this tracks at an individual level
    - SVDP will begin something similar in 2018
    - Some pantries no longer accept or distribute sweets due to the high rate of diabetes
    - Free Store has a calendar for their activities trying to obtain a copy
    - Food is now ordered on line
  - O Dave shared:
    - Trying to reduce or eliminate plastic bags, but providing canvas is problematic
    - Having difficulty getting people to bring them back
    - In 2011 served 6 million meals, this year it is projected 24 million meals
- Thanksgiving –Sue/Barb
  - Jim suggest to have a police officer at the Thanksgiving give away
  - Barb checking with St Xavier for food donations; St Ursula does food drive in the Spring
  - Barb will post donation requests from Parish for Thanksgiving on 10/21
  - Will begin registering people in October for Thanksgiving give away
  - o Give away will be on 11/18 projected 120 families will participate
  - Sue reviewed estimated food needs for the give away
  - Pantry has process in place to manage the distribution
  - At next meeting will revisit the Thanksgiving food list to determine if items need to be cut
- Reviewed what Bank Street is doing for the Holidays

- Ozanam Training at St Boniface Nov 11 9-3PM –Barb
  - Don will be providing the training
  - Will be here to gauge what will be needed
  - Should we use VonderHaar's in appreciation of their generosity?
- Masses Kathy
  - Arranging Mass requires advance notice
  - o 10/29 is the anniversary of the St Boniface founding in 1905
  - o Mass for our donors, one for those we serve and one for members
    - Mass for donors on 10/29 at 10:00
    - Remaining Masses will be in 2018
- Need to determine when to do a recommissioning of the conference
- Counters October 31- Dave and Jim

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- District Council Officers Meeting (Sept 16) Barb
  - o Presented recruitment flyer and personal assessment for Servant Leader
  - What are we doing to conference members to take on responsibility and do succession planning?
  - First step is to disseminate information on the conference workings
- Home Visits/Vouchers Barb
  - Vouchers do not cost the conference anything
  - o Donating to and shopping at a SVdP Retail Store helps to fund vouchers for others
- Membership (Amber, classification) Barb
  - Status of Amber as member has had life changes so is limited in what role she can play; is no longer an active member, but will be an associate member
- Relationship with Parish Jim
  - There is no need to reimburse the church for the use of their facilities SVDP is part of their mission to assist
  - We may give gas card/Christmas gift
